





INFORMATION ABOUT THE TREATMENT OF PERSONAL DATA

Under Section 13 of the Italian <u>Legislative Decree 30 June 2003 no.196</u>, it is noted that INFN Division of Perugia / the Department of Physics - University of Perugia (Italy) - will treat personal data exclusively in execution of the norms of law and regulations and relative to pursuing the specific aims of the institution itself.

Conditions of data treatment - Personal data will be treated legally and fairly, including the use of automatic tools and only for the time necessary to complete the goals for which the data is being collected. Treatment comes under Section 11 and with consideration of Section 100 of the D.Lgs.196/03. Specific security measures are observed to prevent the loss of data, illicit or unfair use and non-authorized access.

The principals and those responsible for data treatment

- in the case of INFN: the Principal is the Italian National Institute for Nuclear Physics (INFN), Via Enrico Fermi, 40 00044 Frascati (Roma), Italy; those Responsible for the data treatment are the persons selected with Decree C.D. INFN n.8335/03, that is here the Director of the Division INFN, via Alessandro Pascoli, Perugia (Italy), where these data are collected:
- in the case of the Department of Physics: the Principal is the University of Perugia Piazza Università, 1 06123 Perugia (Italy); those Responsible for the data treatment are the persons selected with Decree 01 June 2004 n.1077 by the Rector of the University of Perugia, that is here the Head of the Department of Physics, via Alessandro Pascoli, Perugia (Italy), where these data are collected.

The giving of data is non-obligatory - The user is free to supply his own personal data. It is to be noted, however, that the absence of data will make it impossible to achieve the goals related to the treatment of data.

Rights of the parties - The subjects to whom the data refer to are guaranteed the exercise of their rights as specified by the Sections 7, 8, 9 and 10 of the D.Lgs. no. 196/03. Applications aimed at exercising these rights must be addressed to the Principal of the treatment (and CC to Director of this INFN Division or the Director of this Physics Department, as appropriate).
