

Information for Students of the Department of Physics and Geology
Start of teaching activity 2020-2021

For all those who will choose to attend lessons in classroom (i.e. face to face), it is important to be able to do so safely. For this reason, we have prepared a Department Operational Plan that implements the Provisions of our University regarding the management of the Covid-19 health emergency. In the following, rules taken from our Operational Plan are listed. **The student is required to follow them scrupulously to protect everyone's health and to have the right to attend lessons in classroom.**

The Department is accessible through separate entrances for students of Degree Courses in Physics and those of Degree Courses in Geology. The two entrances are shown on the maps on the following pages. The body temperature, to be measured before leaving your house, must not be higher than 37.5 °C, you must not be subjected to isolation, or have had contact with people who are positive for SARS-CoV-2 in the previous 14 days. **It is forbidden to access the Department to all those who show significant changes in body temperature or other symptoms potentially attributable to the contagion from Covid-19. Anyone who verifies the onset of symptoms during the period of stay at the Department is forced to leave it.**

The student is **allowed to enter the Department only if equipped with a healthy face mask**. He will access the classroom following the indicated path and will sanitize his hands using the hydroalcoholic solution made available near the entrance to the classroom.

In the classroom, he **will have to sit in the seat marked with the number assigned to him. It is forbidden to occupy a place other than the one assigned**. In the classroom, the student must remain in the assigned place and wear the face mask during the lesson and in the breaks between lessons.

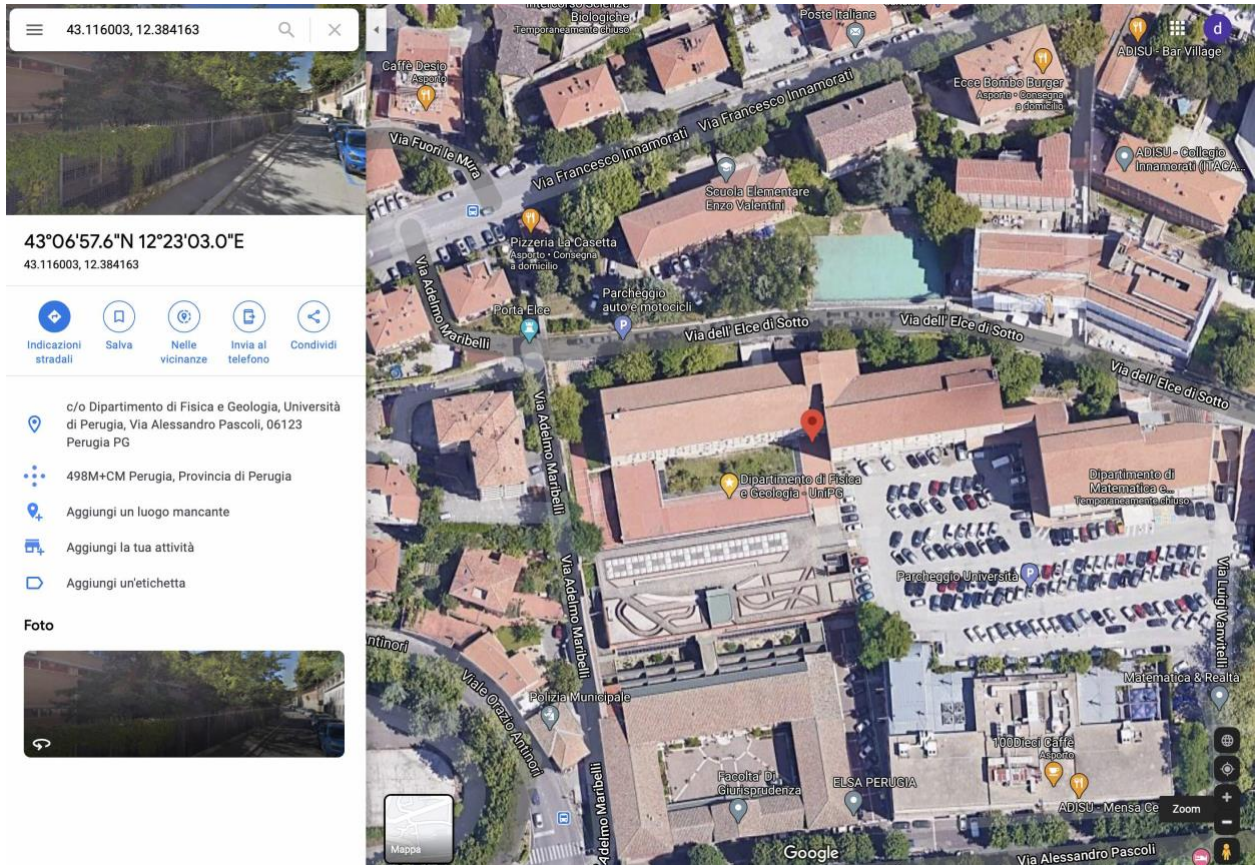
Should the student temporarily leave the classroom, he/she must follow the indicated exit path, observing the prescribed distance. During the break between two lessons, the student will not stop within the Department, while he will be able to stop in the open spaces, respecting the prescribed distance. At the end of the lessons, students will leave the classroom following the exit path, going out of the Department as soon as possible.

Master's degree in Physics, first year, room D.

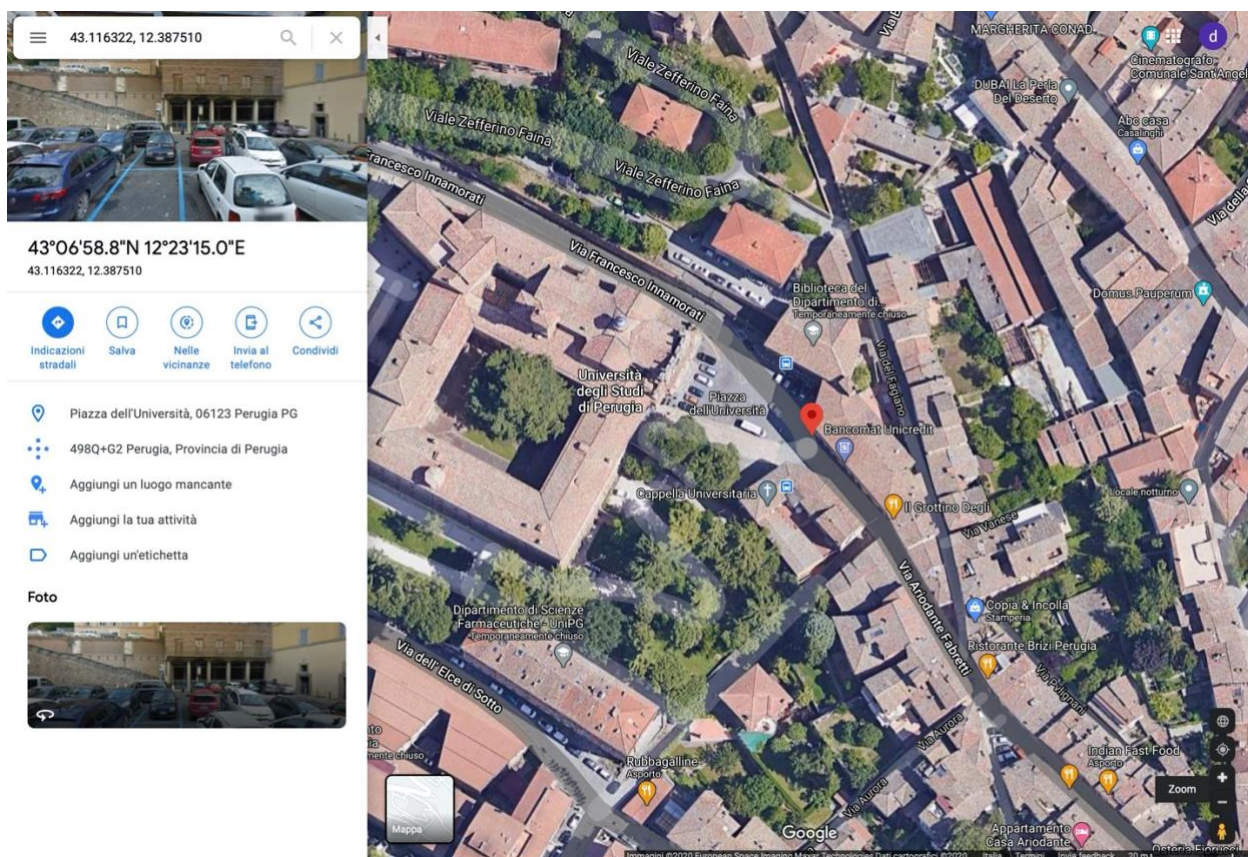
Master's degree in Physics, second year, room E.
